In this talk Philip will be sharing observations that he had made about the pressures and challenges in primary care before Covid arrived and then thinking about the consequences of the pandemic on both practitioners and patients. He will end up with some thoughts about the future.

Philip is a Psychoanalyst in private practice working with adults and couples, and an Organisational Consultant, providing consultation to a wide range of organisations, including primary care. He worked in the Adult Department of the Tavistock & Portman NHS Foundation Trust between 1994 and 2012, he was the Clinical Director from 2007.

During his career, he has been responsible for the creation of innovative services; developing a model for understanding organisations called the Healthy Organisation Model and designed the Primary Care Psychotherapy Consultation Service (PCPCS) in City and Hackney.

His book, *The Curiosity Drive: Our Need for Inquisitive Thinking*, was published by Phoenix Publishing House in November 2020.
